Announcements for the AMS-9 Conference Proceedings

It was really nice for the AMS community to gather together in Nagoya and enjoy comradeship and critical discussion concerning advances in technical design as well as achievements in research applications. We hope that all participants enjoyed the food and customs of Japan.

Now, the next step for us is to prepare a volume of Proceedings. We are very sorry for the delay in distributing information on manuscripts. Our computer system was damaged just after the Conference, and we are behind schedule for the proceedings volume. You should be aware that few days are left before the deadline for submitting manuscripts on November 1, 2002.

The AMS-9 Conference Proceedings will be published as a special volume of Nuclear Instruments and Methods B (NIM B). A page limit on each paper must be kept to ensure the volume does not exceed 1000 pages. Invited papers are therefore limited to 8 journal pages, and regular contributions to 4 pages.

Authors instructions for the AMS-9 Proceeding volume, prepared by Dr. Henrik Andersen (editor of NIM B), will be attached to this mail. You also can download them as a pdf file from the AMS-9 website, along with a sample paper that appeared in the AMS-8 Proceedings volume.

We recommend that all contributors prepare their manuscripts using MS-Word or a similar popular word-processing software.
